

In 1991 Lionel, the oldest producer of model trains in America, joined forces with America's national museum, the renowned Smithsonian Institution, to offer the first in a collection of museum quality O-Scale model trains. Beginning with 500 limited edition Dreyfuss Hudson loco-



motives in 1992, each year will bring a new addition to the Lionel Smithsonian Collection. Also part of the Dreyfuss Hudson offering will be all thirteen passenger cars of the famous 20th Century Limited train, complete with matching serial numbers.

Several of these limited edition pieces were ordered by customers in Europe, prompting Lionel to consider a similar select offering abroad to feature European locomotives. The result? Lionel will offer a 1:43.5 scale model of the famous BR50 locomotive. Working in cooperation with the Bayerisches Eisenbahnmuseum in Nordlingen, Germany, Lionel has created an exact scale model of the BR50, complete with prototypical sound system. Not only does this system replicate the original sounds of the BR50, but also all its functions, including full whistle, compressors, brake release, blowers and synchronized chuff. The Lionel BR50 is truly an exact replica of the prototype in both detail and sound.

The Lionel BR50 will be produced in a limited edition of 250 unique pieces. Each locomotive will carry its own individual number plate which




will also serve as its serial number. The BR50 will come with a patented operational roller base and plexiglass cover, so that the locomotive can be operated in place. Additionally, each locomotive will be accompanied by a five-color limited edition lithograph poster of the BR50; the poster

number will match the serial number of the locomotive.

Finally, when the BR50 locomotive is ready for delivery in June of 1993, each customer will be invited to the Bayerisches Eisenbahnmuseum in Nordlingen, Germany to get their BR50, see the

real BR50, and actually ride behind the locomotive on a two-hour excursion trip.

We invite you to compare our BR50 model with any other European prototype O-Scale model you have ever seen. Combined with its sound system, our objective is to produce the finest European prototype O-Scale locomotives ever offered.


